SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

Your work will be professionally printed on a display board for the Jury to review. Here's how to make sure your work will be print ready:

The work you export from your design software for submission must be:

- 5,400 pixels WIDE by 3,600 pixels TALL (5,400 x 3,600)
- NOT a screen shot of your work, images will print blurry on display boards.
- preferably oriented horizontally (landscape orientation)

If working in SketchUp, export using the following steps:

- WINDOWS Users:
 - Adjust your SketchUp window to the preferred aspect ratio
 - Click 'File' > 'Export' > '2D Graphic'
 - Make sure '.jpg' is selected in the dropdown menu
 - Click 'Options...'
 - Deselect 'Use view size'
 - Input 5,400 pixels for the WIDTH, the HEIGHT will be auto-generated based on your SketchUp window's aspect ratio*
 - Click 'OK'
 - Click 'Export'

**For Windows users, the shape of your SketchUp window sets the aspect ratio for what you export*

- MAC Users:
 - Click 'File' > 'Export' > '2D Graphic'
 - Make sure '.jpg' is selected in the dropdown menu
 - Click 'Options...'
 - Deselect 'Use view size'
 - Click the chain icon to unlock the aspect ratio
 - Input 5,400 pixels for the WIDTH and 3,600 pixels for the HEIGHT
 - Click 'OK'
 - Click 'Export'

PHOTO

If you are taking a photo of a physical model, we recommend the following:

- If using a smart phone, set your camera to HDR (High Dynamic Range) setting
- Take the photo horizontally (landscape orientation)
- Take the photo in an uncluttered and well-lit area, avoiding the use of the camera's flash setting if possible
- Do not apply any unnecessary smartphone filters (some basic photo editing is allowed)
- When importing to another device or exporting to send in an email, choose the largest photo size if prompted
- Please review your images carefully before submitting
- Make sure they meet the above guidelines for best print quality (5,400 pixels x 3,600 pixels)
- Make sure these images are what you want the professional jury to review
- Triple check that your images are clear and sharp, and the proportions are constrained (not stretched/squished)
